Non-places can mean imaginary and fictional places, or places which only exist in our subjective world. In French, non-places (non-lieux) may also refer to things which have never happened - *Quelque chose qui n'a pas lieu*. When employed in the field of anthropology, it's often used to refer to spaces of transience which are not significant enough to be regarded as proper "places". This exhibition does not attempt to define the term through visual means. It is rather an artistic and visual brainstorming inspired by the term.
